

Business Services Agreement Policy

Policy

- 1. The West Piedmont Workforce Development Board has a strategic goal of *creating a workforce system that is relevant to business customers*.
- 2. Core and required program partners will be encouraged to participate on an integrated business services team if they have unsubsidized employment as a desired outcome.
- 3. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Title I Adult and Dislocated Worker service provider will take the Lead to form and manage the business services team.
- 4. The integrated business services team will work with the West Piedmont Workforce Development Board's Business Engagement Committee.
- 5. Business needs and expectations will drive the workforce services in the West Piedmont Local Workforce Development Area.
- 6. The integrated business services team will work to align and integrate business development activities with a goal to:
 - a. Create a single point of contact for businesses across partner agencies.
 - b. Establish a collaborative outreach and recruitment structure.
 - c. Coordinate workforce services and training options.
 - d. Leverage resources.
 - e. Share performance outcomes.
 - f. Create and manage a talent pipeline in existing and emerging in-demand industries and occupations.
 - g. Identify skill and knowledge gaps between what business needs and expects and what training options are available.
 - h. Work with Education to enhance or establish short-term training options for portable or stackable credential/certification opportunities.
 - Work with Economic Development representatives to ensure a dynamic approach to meeting the ever-changing needs of business and industry as the in-demand sector landscape grows or diminishes.
