

Individual Employment Plan & Individual Service Strategy

Policy

- The Individual Employment Plan is an individualized career service under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act and is developed jointly by the participant and the WIOA staff person.
- 2. The Individual Employment Plan is a document that provides a summary of where a participant has been, where are they now, where do they want to go, how will they get there, and what is the progress.
- 3. Detail should be provided in the participant's case notes to support the information on the Individual Employment Plan.
- 4. The Plan will change over time, as necessary, to meet the needs of the individual.
- 5. Participants should get a copy of the Individual Employment Plan initially and after changes are made.
- 6. The Individual Employment Plan:
 - a. Is the overall career planning and case management strategy.
 - b. Provides an update on strategies and activities as they occur.
 - c. Documents a participant's progress, activities completed and benchmarks reached.
 - d. Identifies other accomplishments.
 - e. Is used to show a roadmap to achieve measurable and attainable short-term and long-term goals.
 - f. Serves as a tool to monitor and evaluate the participant's progress.
