

Tracking Policy

1. The West Piedmont Workforce Development Board understands that fact-based decision-making is essential to maintaining a high-performing local workforce system.
2. Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act participant information is input and tracked through the Virginia Workforce Exchange.
3. West Piedmont Workforce Development Board will track additional information to assist in decision-making as follows:
 - a. Percent of dollars spent on out-of-school youth.
 - b. Percent of dollars spent on direct client costs.
 - c. Number of individuals entering each American Job Center.
 - d. Referrals made to Core Program Partners.
 - e. Referrals made to resources other than Core Program Partners.
 - f. Number of training dollars spent in each of the focused in-demand industries and occupations.
4. Additional tracking may be requested by the West Piedmont Workforce Development Board or Chief Elected Officials.
