

Tracking Policy

- 1. The West Piedmont Workforce Development Board understands that fact-based decision-making is essential to maintaining a high-performing local workforce system.
- 2. Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act participant information is input and tracked through the Virginia Workforce Exchange.
- 3. West Piedmont Workforce Development Board will track additional information to assist in decision-making as follows:
 - a. Percent of dollars spent on out-of-school youth.
 - b. Percent of dollars spent on direct client costs.
 - c. Number of individuals entering each American Job Center.
 - d. Referrals made to Core Program Partners.
 - e. Referrals made to resources other than Core Program Partners.
 - f. Number of training dollars spent in each of the focused in-demand industries and occupations.
- 4. Additional tracking may be requested by the West Piedmont Workforce Development Board or Chief Elected Officials.
